- Holt's 15.0 points/game leads the team and ranks 15th in the league.

<p>Tulsa, OK- The Tulsa Shock picked up their second straight win and third in four games as they defeated the Minnesota Lynx 92-79 at the BOK Center Friday night.</p> <p>Scholanda Robinson led the Shock with a career high 20 points as the Shock improved to 3-3 on the season and 2-1 over the Lynx. Tulsa held Minnesota to just 38.2 percent from the field and won the turnover battle 21-18.</p> <p>Tulsa shot 50 percent from the field on 32 of 64 shooting, including 9 of 17 from beyond the arc. The Shock led for the majority, falling behind by just three in the first quarter and leading by as much as 22 in the third. Five Shock players scored in double digits.</p> <p>Rookie guard Natasha Lacy continued her hot streak, scoring in double figures for the second straight game and dish at least five assists in five straight. She also played a career high in minutes, playing nearly 32 in the game.</p> <p>Chante Black also continued a streak, grabbing at least ten rebounds in four straight games and five of six this season.</p>

Tulsa, OK- The Tulsa Shock won their first game at the BOK Center when they defeated the Indiana Fever 79-74 on Saturday. Rookie guard Natasha Lacy had a career night when she racked up 15 points and five assists against the Fever. She also recorded her first made three-point basket, a half court heave at the end of the third quarter to cut the Fever's lead to just three. Lacy, Amber Holt and Plenette Pierson all came off the bench to combine for 43 points, outscoring the Shock starters by seven points. There were seven ties and 16 lead changes in a tightly contested battle between the two teams. Tulsa continued their dominance under the basket, outscoring Indiana 38-20 in points in the paint. For the fifth straight game, everyone on Tulsa's roster saw playing time in the first half.

Tulsa, OK – The Phoenix Mercury tied up the all-time head to head record between the two teams as they beat the Tulsa Shock 110-96 at the BOK Center. The Shock weren't able to find an answer for a three-point shooting barrage courtesy of Penny Taylor and Diana Taurasi. The duo combined for 14 three-pointers and finished with 64 points between them. Phoenix made 16 three-point shots, which tied the league record for the most three-point shots made in a game. For the fourth-straight game, everyone on the Shock roster saw time on the court. Amber Holt had a team-high 20 points, while four others scored in double figures. Tulsa outscored Phoenix in the paint 48-28, but lost the battle of the boards 45-39. The Mercury also outscored the Shock 18-7 on second chance opportunities and 48-12 from behind the arc. Phoenix built a 15-point lead in the first quarter with the help of Taurasi's shooting. She had 15 points on 5 of 5 from behind the arc, propelling the Mercury to a 35-23 lead at the end of the first. The Shock battled back in the second, going on a 23-6 run over a six-minute period to take a 50-49 lead just before halftime.

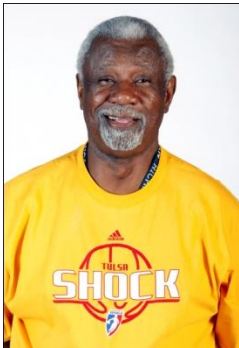

## NOLAN RICHARDSON

### WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.
- Won first pre-season game, 90-80, over the Seattle Storm.

### GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
